He would also like to purchase evidence tracking system. The one he is looking at is \$3000. He is checking on a yearly fee.

The pd also needs duty ammo. This will cost around \$500

Chief Lewis is working on policies for the board to approve. After the policies are approved, he will be able to apply for more grants

He also talked about joining a drug task force that could potentially bring in some operating funds for the police department.

Budget Items

City Clerk Rachel Reed prepared 2 different budgets one with 5 officers and one with 4. The budget with five officers is very out of balance and it doesn't look like it can work. The budget with four officers is a lot more realistic.

Alderman Rockwell made a motion to move forward with the budget with 4 officers. Alderman Hunter seconded the motion.
